


Laser Remote Control

Button	Function	Description
(b)	Switching on / off	To turn the laser on and off in REM mode. In any standalone mode, except SLA mode, pressing 2 seconds activates the REM mode.
	Auto	For an automatically running show
400	Music	For a sound-activated show. The blue music LED indicator is flashing when a sound signal is detected.
	Sound sensitivity B ➤ 1 ~ 9	In a sound-activated show, press the music button $+ B + '1\sim 9'$ to set the sensitivity $- '9'$ is the most sensitive setting.
11/11	Colour changing	Cycle through programmed colours, red & green, green, red.
A/c	Pattern changing	To show and change patterns.
0~9	Fixed pattern	Choose your favourite patterns from 1 to 48.
0	Pattern repeat	The previous and current pattern perform a cycle.
