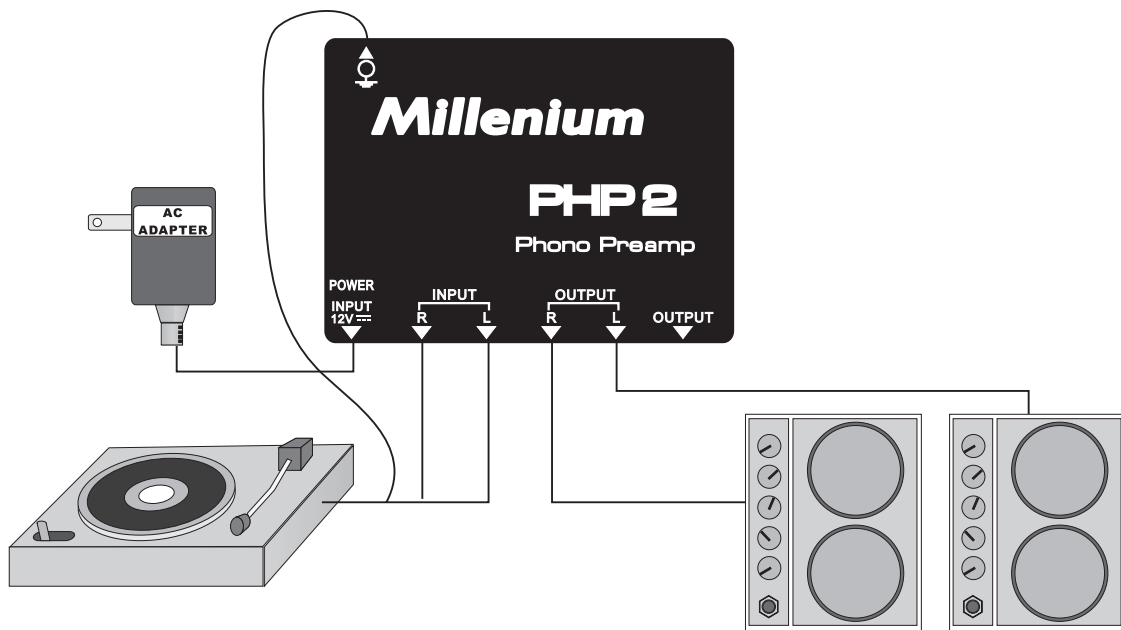


## Features

- Stereo RCA input sockets to connect a turntable

## Technical specifications

- Operating voltage: 12 V<sub>DC</sub> via supplied mains adapter (centre pin = negative pole)
